"CAMPER RULES" - IMPORTANT INFORMATION! Please read the following information thoroughly, as all rules and regulations must be strictly adhered to.

SoCal District Summer Youth Camp Rules

* <u>REGISTRATION BEGINS AT 1:00 P.M. Tuesday June 25, 2024</u>

- 1. Rules for acceptance and participation in this camp are the same without regards to race, color, age, national origin, sex or handicap.
- 2. There will be a nurse on campgrounds for any minor injuries or sickness.
- 3. Each camper is given a bunk and mattress, but must provide his/her own bedding and personal belongings such as towels, soap and flashlight, insect repellant, etc, be prepared for cold weather at night.
- 4. Camp cannot be responsible for lost or stolen articles, but will establish a lost and found center. Unclaimed articles will be given away if not claimed after 30 days.
- 5. <u>BOYS/MEN</u>: All boys are to dress modestly at all times. NO SHORTS may be worn. Shirts must be worn over T-shirts. Swimming is available to all campers. Swimming attire will only be allowed in pool area at designated swim time. Clean, yet casual clothes are to be worn during the evening service. Boys hairstyle and dress are to conform to the standard set by the SoCal District UPCI for Summer Camps, which is as follows:

"In keeping with the spirit of the camp, boys will not be wearing clothing that is tight fitting. All shirts should have sleeves on them. We ask that all boys have a conservative haircut that becometh a Christian. In keeping of the unity in the District, there will be no mustaches or beards allowed. No punk styles of hair or attire will be allowed..."

- 6. **GIRLS/WOMEN:** All girls are to dress modestly at all times. Wear casual dresses to all functions of camp. No pants, culottes, gauchos or shorts are allowed. Swimming is available to all campers. Swimming attire will only be allowed in pool area during designated swim time. Clean, yet casual clothes are to be worn during the evening service. Girls dress is to conform to the standard set by SoCal District UPC for Summer Camps, which is as follows: "In keeping with the spirit of the camp, girls will not be wearing clothing that is tight. The skirts will cover the knee and their dresses and blouses will have sleeves in them. (No cap sleeves or sleeveless dresses will be permitted). Gauchos will not be permitted. Culottes will not be permitted since there are so many varied opinions among the constituency. No skirts or dresses with slits above the knee. Necklines should be decent and modest. Also, no pedal pushers, slacks, shorts, etc. will be allowed. (We also ask that no makeup or jewelry such as earrings, necklaces, bracelets, etc. be worn. No punk hair or attire will be allowed...) "
- 7. Each camper is expected to share in the workload of the camp.
- 8. Foul language, disrespect, or continual misbehavior is grounds for dismissal from camp. If dismissed, no refund will be given. Also, no weapons or knives of ANY kind.
- 9. The camp will have a snack bar, so bring extra money.
